Vale Lorraine Murphy (24/07/1936 – 1/04/2025)



Our dear friend Lorraine Murphy passed away peacefully on April 1, aged 88 years.

Lorraine's husband Danny was a foundation member of Melbourne North, attending from the inaugural meeting in November 1994, and becoming the Club's first newsletter editor.

Lorraine joined a little later, in March 1997. Sadly, Danny died soon after, but Lorraine continued her membership to become a major contributor to the life of the Club.

She became President of the Club in 2002. She was elected to be President again in 2013 but took over earlier when her predecessor died in office. Thus, she was effectively President for three years.

She was also involved with planning Club trips – to Bright in 1999 (the first Club trip away), to Lakes Entrance in 2000, and to French Island in 2002. Throughout her active years in the Club (over 25 years) Lorraine was always prominent in welfare for her fellow members, as well as participation in lunches, outings and excursions. She is survived by her three children, five grandchildren, and their partners. Our Club was well represented at the wonderful Celebration of Life event held for Lorraine. Family members, and other speakers, spoke of her compassion, intellect, wit, generosity, belief in social justice and knowledge and understanding of world events. She was described as "a mosaic of compassion, humour, opinion and generosity".
